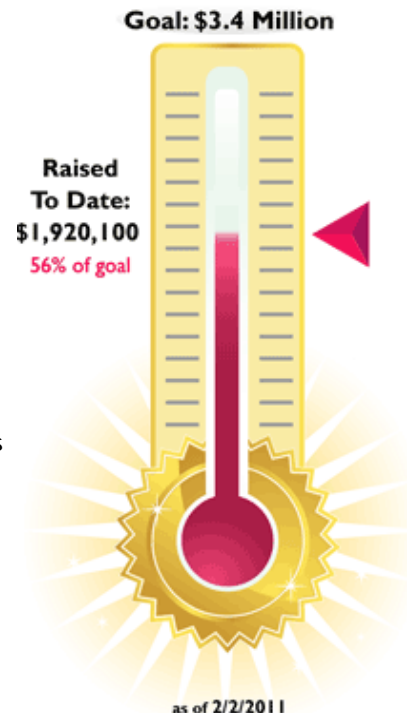
Dear "Making Room for Mental Health" Investor,
